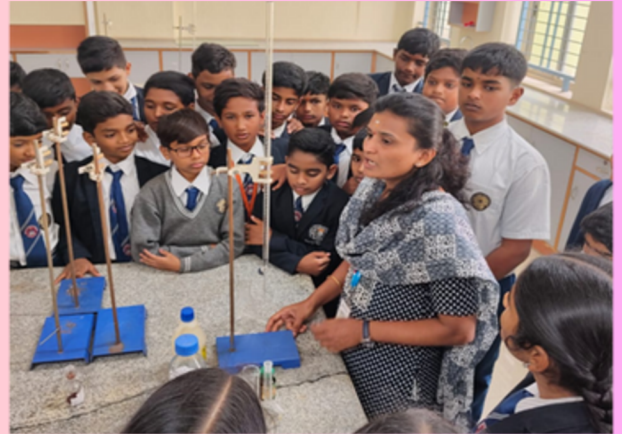
They cleaned the school campus with full pledge energy. The Swachh Bharat observation not only helped in keeping the campus clean but also created a sense of social responsibility among the students.

Students watched the film with great interest and enthusiasm, and also maintained discipline throughout the show.

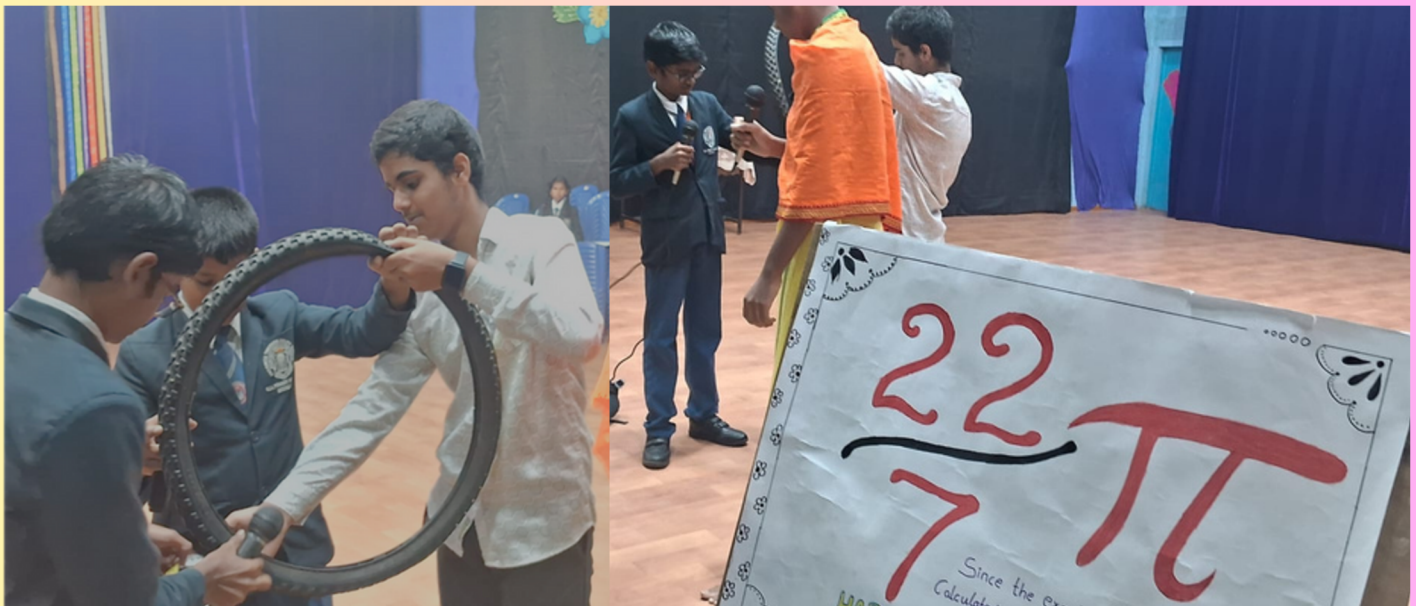


## PI APPROXIMATION DAY

### Some interesting facts about pi:

1. Pi is an irrational number, meaning it cannot be expressed as a finite decimal or fraction.
2. Pi is essential in calculations involving circles, spheres, and other curved shapes.
3. Pi has been calculated to over 31.4 trillion digits using advanced computational methods.
